## 5. RIGHT TO LIFE

- 1. **1.** No person shall be deprived of his life intentionally, except in the execution of a sentence of a court following his conviction of an offence for which this penalty is provided by Act.
- 2. **2.** Deprivation of life shall not be regarded as having been inflicted in contravention of the provisions of this Article when it results from the use of force to such extent and in such circumstances as are prescribed by law and as are reasonably justifiable
  - 1. a. In defence of any person from violence; or
  - 2. **b.** In order to effect an arrest or to prevent the escape of a person detained, if the person who is being arrested or who is escaping is believed on reasonable grounds to be in possession of a firearm; or
  - 3. **c.** For the purpose of suppressing a riot, insurrection or mutiny.
