Article 7

The human person is sacred. The human person is inviolable. The state shall have the obligation to respect it and to protect it. Every individual has the right to life, to freedom, to security, the free development of his or her personality, to corporal integrity, and especially to protection against physical mutilation. The Senegalese people recognise the existence of sacred and inalienable human rights as the basis of any human community, of peace and justice in Senegal and the world. Men and women shall be equal in law. No one in Senegal shall have any liabilities or privileges based upon places of birth, status or family.
